Facts for change

Facts for change is a report series that aims to provide a better understanding of the conditions for different demographic groups based on, among other things, origin, and residential areas. The reports contain statistics on demography, labor market, education, housing, entrepreneurship, income, voter turnout and more. Recent reports have explored Swedish citizens born abroad and their children born in Sweden. The statistics come from authorities such as Statistics Sweden. For the first time in Sweden, three groups are studied and compared: those born abroad, their children and the entire population in Sweden. Will it be better for the next generation?

Today, two million foreign-born people live in Sweden. **56.6 percent** of those born abroad were **born outside Europe**. A large majority of those born outside Europe come from the **Asian (68.4 percent)** and **African (20.2 percent) continents**. People from Somalia, Eritrea, and Ethiopia make up more than half of the African group (59.5 percent), while citizens from Syria, Iraq, and Iran make up more than half of the Asian group (53.4 percent).

People born in Somalia, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Syria, Iraq, and Iran make up 48.6 percent of all non-European born and 27.5 percent of all foreign born. The numbers above do not include the children born in Sweden with one or both parents from the countries.
